

MFSC Board Goals 2005-2006



1. Concise/Directed Meetings-Outcome focused
 - Committee Reports e-mailed to the President the Sunday before meeting. President to send agenda with committee reports by 2nd Monday/month. Board members to review, identify questions. Discuss questions at board meeting and then approve. (Will make minutes for secretary easier)
 - Executive committee (officers)-President to use as sounding board, discuss possible ideas etc. These ideas, discussion to be shared with board for informational purpose, share minutes of discussion.
 - Agenda will be timed with goal of meetings to be 2 hours or less. Utilize timer to limit discussion. Suggest that timer is rotated.
2. Continue to grow membership/Recognition of Club
 - Focus on the Bridge program/LTS Outreach. Committee for membership. Community Outreach-Invited local nursing homes to Sunshine competition; shows, "Skate with MFSC" open house after the Olympics. Suggested getting names of LTS skaters to invite to open house. Discussed holding an Open House with Hockey after the Olympics. Feature Hockey on one rink and figure skating on the other.
 - Skater Recognition-notice to schools when tests are passed; News-Herald; End of Year Banquet/Potluck; Channel 12 news. Community recognition of club.
3. Maintain Financial Stability
 - Continue to purchase ice to receive discount
 - Maintain ice costs
 - Offer variety of fund raising options, both Club and individual.
4. Provide "State of the Art" resources to the Mentor Figure Skaters
 - Technology-Dart Fish
 - Variety of coaching options
 - Synchronized skating
 - Well balanced Clinics and classes
 - Competition Options: Sunshine, CIC's, and Synch Tri-State
5. Increase Communication within the club
 - Suggested having mailboxes for families at monitor station. Each family could have a folder. Announcements, ice fees, etc...could be placed in family folder. We would then know who is getting info and who may need contacted.
 - Resurrect the club newsletter, "Scribe". Discussed creating a standard format which information can be changed easily and updated.
